This is a photo of me on the beach at Tallebudgera with my kids Lucy, who's six, Hugh, four, and Ben, who's one. They're all well covered up because I'm really conscious about sun protection. Two years ago, I was diagnosed with discoid lupus after I developed a scaly patch on my head. I went to see a dermatologist, who told me that sunshine aggravates the condition. She told me to be careful about my own sun exposure, and paranoid about my children's. She told me to get them long-sleeved sunshirts to protect their forearms, which are exposed to the sun all the time.

To my dismay, the only long-sleeved sunshirts I could find were expensive and not chlorine resistant, or they were too plain and Lucy refused to wear them.

My neighbour, Maree Mostert, and I decided to create our own line of sunshirts and we launched Babes in the Shade in April this year, selling through our website and some pharmacies. We try to keep our prices below \$40 per shirt, and make them chlorine-resistant and cute so the kids are happy to wear them. We avoid the beach between 10am and 2pm but apart from that I can let the kids stay out longer now and know they're not going to burn.

My aim is that when they get in the bath there are no tan marks on them at all.
